### AWARD FOR STUDENT ATTENDING COLLEGE

- Amount: \$1,500 minimum for student attending a 4-year college, \$750 for student attending Dallas College
- Number of Scholarships: 3 minimum
- The scholarship must be disbursed by September 1 following your graduation from high school.
- The dollar amount of the award will be paid directly to the college or Institute of higher learning (recipient's choice) at the time of registration.

### CRITERIA

- Applicant must either reside in or attend a school within the city limits of Coppel, Texas.
- Applicant must be a member in good standing of the senior class of the high school in attendance.
- The applicant must plan on attending a trade school, community college, college or university of her/his choice as a full-time student (12 hours or more).
- Scholarship awards are limited to those students who have not received a full scholarship.
- Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.
